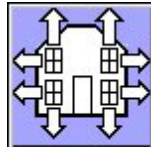

FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Rinse with water and soap. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Inhalation/ Drowsiness:	If inhaled, move the person to fresh air and keep them comfortable. If symptoms such as dizziness, drowsiness, or difficulty breathing occur and persist, seek medical attention.
Ingestion:	DO NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water. Seek medical attention.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use water spray, alcohol-resistant foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide.
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CONTROL MEASURES IF ACCIDENTAL SPILLAGE:

Spillage:	Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13). Ensure the area is ventilated.
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Condition/ Materials To Avoid:	Reactivity: Stable under normal conditions. No dangerous reactions known during normal use. Conditions/Materials to Avoid: Avoid strong oxidising agents, strong acids, and strong alkalis. Keep away from excessive heat, sparks, and open flames. Do not store in direct sunlight.
