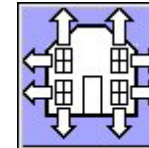

Handling:	Avoid contact with eyes. Use as directed through a dispenser. Do not mix with other chemicals.
Storage:	Store in original, sealed container. Keep in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place. Avoid direct sunlight and heat.

FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Rinse with water.
Eye contact:	Rinse with water for at least 15 minutes; seek medical attention if irritation persists.
Inhalation Drowsiness:	Not likely; move to fresh air if symptoms occur.
Ingestion:	Rinse mouth; do not induce vomiting; get medical help if symptoms persist.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use foam, CO ₂ , dry powder (not flammable). May release carbon oxides under combustion. Use SCBA and appropriate protective gear.
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CONTROL MEASURES IF ACCIDENTAL SPILLAGE:

Spillage:	Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13). Material can create slippery conditions.
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Condition/ Materials To Avoid:	Stable under normal conditions. No dangerous reaction known under conditions of normal use.
