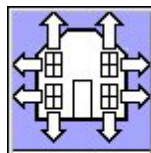

Handling:	Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Ensure sufficient ventilation. Prevent mist generation.
Storage:	Store in original, sealed container. Keep in a cool, well-ventilated place. Protect from extreme temperatures.

FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water.
Eye contact:	Rinse thoroughly with water for 15 minutes; seek medical advice if symptoms persist.
Inhalation/Drowsiness:	Move to fresh air if irritation occurs.
Ingestion:	Rinse mouth with water; seek medical advice if symptoms occur.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use suitable for surrounding fire (water spray, foam, CO ₂). May release toxic fumes when burning. Full SCBA and protective gear.
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CONTROL MEASURES IF ACCIDENTAL SPILLAGE:

Spillage:	Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13). Ensure the area is ventilated.
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Condition/Materials To Avoid:	Stable under normal conditions. No dangerous reactions known during normal use. Avoid strong oxidising agents, strong acids.
