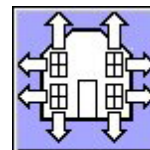

Handling:	Do not eat, drink or smoke during use. Avoid eye and skin contact. Wash hands and face after handling.
Storage:	Store in original container in a dry, cool, and well-ventilated area. Keep containers sealed and upright. Avoid strong acids, bases, oxidisers.

FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Wash with plenty of water and soap. Seek advice if irritation occurs.
Eye contact:	Rinse with clean water for several minutes; remove contact lenses if present. Seek medical help if irritation persists.
Inhalation Drowsiness:	Move to fresh air. Seek medical advice if discomfort continues.
Ingestion:	Rinse mouth. Do NOT give anything by mouth if unconscious. Seek medical advice.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use foam, dry powder, CO2, water mist; DO NOT use: Water jet, dense smoke, toxic fumes on burning, PPE for fire: Full protective gear with SCBA.
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CONTROL MEASURES IF ACCIDENTAL SPILLAGE:

Spillage:	Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13).
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Condition/ Materials To Avoid:	Stable under normal conditions. Avoid strong acids, strong bases, oxidisers, reducers.
