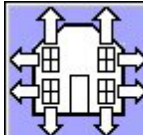

Handling:	Avoid contact with eyes and prolonged skin exposure. Provide adequate ventilation. Wash hands after use.				

Storage:	Store upright in tightly closed original container. Keep in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place. Avoid contact with bleach and strong alkaline products.
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FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Rinse thoroughly with water; remove contaminated clothing.
Eye contact:	Rinse with water for at least 15 minutes; seek medical help if irritation persists.
Inhalation Drowsiness:	Move to fresh air; seek medical attention if discomfort continues.
Ingestion:	Rinse mouth; do NOT induce vomiting; seek medical help.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use foam, CO2, dry powder. May emit carbon oxides/toxic gases in fire. SCBA and full protective gear recommended.
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CONTROL MEASURES IF ACCIDENTAL SPILLAGE:

Spillage:	Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13). Material can create slippery conditions.
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Condition/ Materials To Avoid:	Stable under normal conditions. Avoid bleach, strong acids or alkalis.
