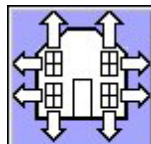

Used For: Daily toilet and urinal cleaning, deodorizing and removal of stale smells. Phosphate-free and clings to surfaces for more effective cleaning.
Physical State: Liquid; Colour: Green; Odour: Apple fragrance; Solubility: Not listed, but likely soluble in water (based on use and composition)

Handling:	Avoid contact with eyes. Use only in well-ventilated areas. Do not mix with other cleaning products.
Storage:	Store in a cool, well-ventilated place. Keep in original, close container. Avoid strong acids, bases and oxidisers.

FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Wash with water.
Eye contact:	Rinse immediately with water; remove contacts; seek medical attention if irritation persists.
Inhalation Drowsiness:	Move to fresh air.
Ingestion:	Rinse mouth; do not induce vomiting; contact a doctor.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use water spray, foam CO ₂ , or dry powder. May release toxic fumes with burned. Full protective gear and SCBA.
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CONTROL MEASURES IF ACCIDENTAL SPILLAGE:

Spillage:	Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13). Material can create slippery conditions.
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Condition/ Materials To Avoid:	Stable under normal conditions. No dangerous reaction known under conditions of normal use. Strong acids, bases and oxidisers.

Disposal:	Dispose of as unused product. Empty containers should be taken to an approved waste handling site for recycling or disposal. Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/regional/national/international regulations.
