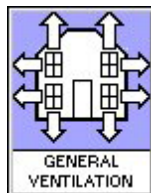

Handling:	Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames, and other ignition sources. Do not pierce or burn can even after use. Do not smoke during use.
Storage:	Store in a cool, well-ventilated area. Protect from sunlight and do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50°C. Store upright and away from oxidisers and ignition sources.

FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Wash thoroughly with soap and water; seek medical help if symptoms persist.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use carbon dioxide, dry chemical, foam. Aerosol container may explode if heated. Full SCBA and protective clothing.
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CONTROL MEASURES IF ACCIDENTAL SPILLAGE:

Spillage:	Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13). Material can create slippery conditions.
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Condition/ Materials To Avoid:	Stable under normal conditions. No dangerous reaction known under conditions of normal use. Avoid sources of ignition, heat, direct sunlight, oxidisers.
