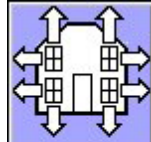

Used For: General floor maintenance and cleaning. Removes grease and scuff marks, leaves a fresh pine fragrance. Suitable for all hard washable surfaces.

Handling:	Avoid contact with eyes and prolonged skin contact. Use with adequate ventilation. Do not mix with other cleaning products.
Storage:	Keep container tightly closed. Protect from freezing and direct sunlight. Store in original container.

FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Wash with plenty of water; remove contaminated clothing.
Eye contact:	Rinse immediately for at least 15 minutes; seek medical help.
Inhalation Drowsiness:	Move to fresh air if symptoms occur.
Ingestion:	Rinse mouth and drink water or milk; seek help if symptoms persist.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use suitable media for surrounding fire (foam, CO ₂ , dry powder). May emit irritating gases or vapours. Firefighting PPE with SCBA.
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CONTROL MEASURES IF ACCIDENTAL SPILLAGE:

Spillage:	Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13). Material can create slippery conditions.
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Condition/ Materials To Avoid:	Stable under normal conditions. No dangerous reaction known under conditions of normal use. Avoid extreme temperatures.

Disposal:	Dispose of as unused product. Empty containers should be taken to an approved waste handling site for recycling or disposal. Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/regional/national/international regulations.
