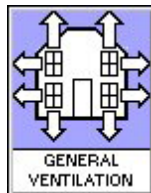

Used For: Cleaning and maintaining polished floors. Removes dirt, heel marks and restores gloss on surfaces like tiles, linoleum, wooden floors, and safety floors.

Handling:	Avoid contact with eyes. Provide adequate ventilation during use. Do not mix with bleach.
Storage:	Store in tightly closed original container. Keep in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place. Protect from freezing and direct sunlight.

FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Rinse with water.
Eye contact:	Rinse immediately with plenty of water for 15 minutes; remove contacts; seek medical help if irritation persists.
Inhalation Drowsiness:	Move to fresh air; seek help if breathing discomfort continues.
Ingestion:	Rinse mouth; seek medical advice if symptoms occur.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use carbon dioxide, dry powder, or foam. May emit toxic fumes during combustion. Full SCBA and protective clothing.
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CONTROL MEASURES IF ACCIDENTAL SPILLAGE:

Spillage:	Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13). Material can create slippery conditions.
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Condition/ Materials To Avoid:	Stable under normal conditions. No dangerous reaction known under conditions of normal use. Avoid Bleach, strong oxidising agents, reducing agents.
