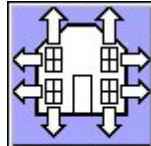

Handling:	Ensure good ventilation during use. Avoid contact with eyes and prolonged contact with skin. Do not eat, drink, or smoke while using the product.
Storage:	Store in a well-ventilated place, in the original container. Keep cool and protect from sunlight.

FIRST AID MEASURES IF HEALTH EFFECTED:

Skin contact:	Wash immediately with water.
Eye contact:	Rinse with plenty of water for several minutes; remove contact lenses if possible; seek medical help if irritation persists.
Inhalation Drowsiness:	Move to fresh air.
Ingestion:	Rinse mouth; call a poison centre or doctor if feeling unwell.

FIRE RISK & FIGHTING MEASURES:

Extinguisher:	Use Water spray, dry powder, foam, carbon dioxide. Toxic fumes may be released in fire. Full SCBA and protective clothing.
