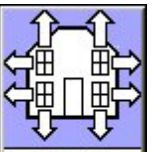

Handling:	Avoid sources of ignition; no smoking. Do not breathe vapour or mist. Use only in well-ventilated areas. Wash hands after handling.
Storage:	Store in tightly closed containers in a cool, well-ventilated area. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Store upright and in original packaging.
